## **Pacifier Policy**

## Policy:

All child pacifiers used will be provided by the child's parent/guardian. Children will only use the pacifier provided by their parent/guardian.

## **Procedure:**

- Schools will not provide "center pacifiers." Pacifiers must be provided by families.
  - If a child's pacifier is left at home, a team member will contact the parents to see if they are able to bring a pacifier to the center.
  - If parents are unable to bring a pacifier to the center, ask the parents on Procare if they are interested in buying a pacifier.
    - Pacifiers are \$5.00 each.
    - Communicate with your Director if a parent would like to purchase a
      pacifier. The Director needs to assign a one-time fee to the parent for the
      pacifier.
    - This pacifier will be sent home with the parent that day or kept on the child's designated hook. It will belong to that child only.
- We encourage that all pacifiers are labeled. An acceptable form of labeling is the use of a
  permanent marker such as a Sharpie<sup>®</sup>. (Sharpie<sup>®</sup> markers are certified non-toxic). This may
  need to be done more than once to ensure the pacifier remains labeled appropriately.
- Pacifiers will be stored in the child's classroom on the hanging pacifier board, in the child's cubby or on a hook inside the classroom cabinet. All pacifier hooks will be labeled with the child's name.
- Pacifiers may not be left on the floor, in seats or in cribs when not being used. They must be placed back on the hook labeled with the child's name.
- If a child puts another child's pacifier in their mouth, the pacifier will be properly and thoroughly sanitized before it is given back to the correct child.
- Pacifier use during daily activities should be discouraged in the classrooms with mobile children as they can hinder language development and pose a sanitary concern. However, pacifiers will be used at the discretion of the child's parent/guardian.
